1. Level of the Book

Overall Level:

- Beginner to lower-intermediate (A1 to A2 on the CEFR scale)

Language Focus:

- Basic sentence structures, common vocabulary, and simple reading comprehension exercises.

Grammar Complexity:

- Mostly simple present and past tense, basic sentence patterns (S+V, S+V+O, S+V+C).

Vocabulary:

- Everyday topics like fruits, seasons, school subjects, animals, jobs, and geography.

Reading Length & Complexity:

- Short paragraphs with repetition, simple sentence structures, and contextual support through vocabulary lists.

2. Target Audience

Age Group:

- Elementary school students (ages 7–12) or early-stage English learners.

English Proficiency Level:

- A1-A2 learners who need structured reading practice.

Purpose of Use: V

- Vocabulary building, sentence structuring, and simple reading comprehension.

3. Justification for Level and Audience

- The book includes basic sentence patterns that are useful for beginner learners.
- Vocabulary is presented in a structured manner with translations, which is helpful for young learners or students in an EFL (English as a Foreign Language) environment.
- There is sentence diagram training and writing exercises, which suggests that the book is designed for learners who need structured learning support rather than independent reading.
- Each unit follows a consistent pattern: reading passage → vocabulary explanation → sentence training → translation exercises → vocabulary test. This reinforces the learning process.

2. For Self-Study

- Follow the reading → vocabulary → writing exercises method.
- Use vocabulary tests as self-check quizzes.

3. For Level Placement

- If a student scores 0-10 points, they need more basic reading practice.
- If a student scores 11-20 points, they are at the beginner level (A1).
- If a student scores 21-30 points, they are at the A2 level and ready for Book 3.
